

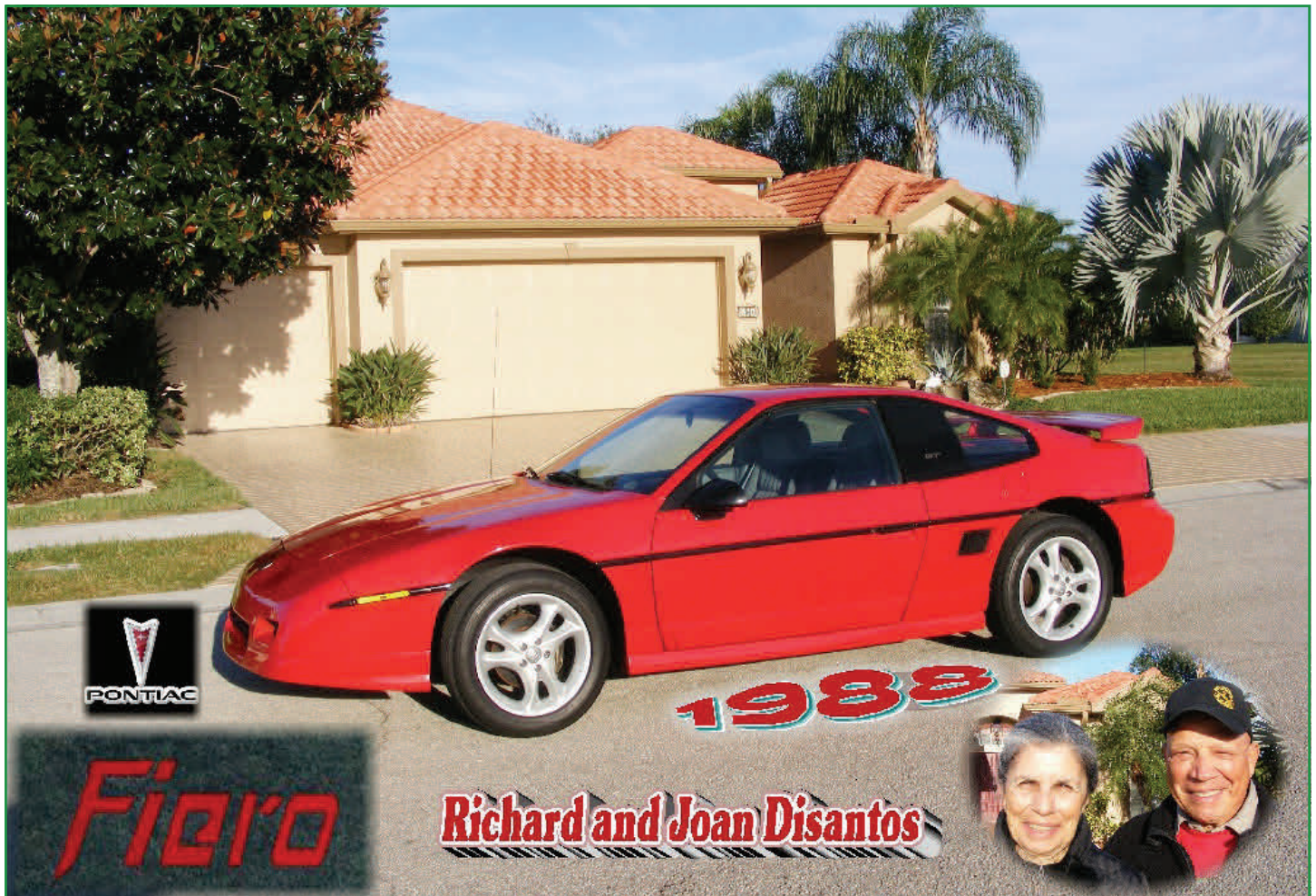

Another first from General Motors -- in 1984 GM introduced the first and only mass produced mid-engine sports car by a U.S. manufacturer. Many technologies incorporated in the Fiero design such as plastic body panels were radical for its time. It had a five year production run to 1988. The Fiero 2M4 (two-seat, Mid-engine, four-cylinder) was on Car and Driver magazines Ten Best list for 1984. The 1984 Fiero was the official Pace Car of the Indianapolis 500 for 1984, beating out the new 1984 Chevrolet Corvette for the honor. Of the vehicles sold in the American market from 1984 to 1988 the FIERO was the SECOND SAFEST VEHICLE SOLD, only the Volvo 740 dl STATION WAGON HAD A BETTER RATING.

Richard and Joan Disantos Fiero is an example of an original 1988 model and

they are in our unofficial "Hall of Fame" consisting of some of our members whose collector car they have and show today was purchased by them new and they are proud to state at events "I bought it new"!

Richard saw an article in Road and Track magazine -- June 1988 issue -- about collectible cars of the future and what to buy new in 1988 and keep as it becomes collectible in later years. The article featured the 1988 Fiero as one of those cars and Richard and Joan needing a second car at that time purchased this nice little sport car and have maintained it in beautiful condition. It only has 72000 miles on it....barely broken in! They purchased it from the dealer in Lisbon, New York. It sports a 4 cylinder engine with a 5 speed Getrag transmission.

Like most of us first coming to Florida Richard and Joan played the "Snowbird" scene living part time in Punta Gorda and then in North Port from 1998 to 2006 before becoming permanent Venice residents in Venice Palms and leaving Lisbon, New York (St. Lawrence County) behind and also one of their favorite activities -- both working for the Watkins Glen International Formula I Races for many years.

They found our club by attending our Annual Collector Car Show in October for the past two years and joined up with us in November of this past year. We enthusiastically welcome you into our fold and wish you many wonderful years of fond memories involved with our events and activities.

HISTORICAL VEHICLE - submitted by Chuck Ford



1910 Rambler Model 54 Touring



The **Thomas B. Jeffery Company** of Chicago, Illinois and builder of the **Rambler** bicycle, constructed its first prototype automobile in 1897. After receiving positive reviews at the 1899 Chicago International Exhibition & Tournament and the first National Automobile Show in New York City, Jeffery decided to enter the automobile business in 1900.

Jeffery started commercially mass-producing automobiles in 1902 and by the end of the year had produced 1,500 motorcars, one-sixth of all existing in the USA and was the second largest auto manufacturer at that time.

Rambler experimented the steering wheel, but it was decided that such features

were too advanced for the motoring public of the day, so the first production Ramblers were tiller-steered. Rambler was the first to equip cars with a spare wheel-and-tire assembly. This allowed the driver, when experiencing a flat tire, to exchange the spare wheel & tire for the flat one.

In 1914, Charles T. Jeffery, Thomas B. Jeffery's son, replaced the Rambler brand name with Jeffery in honor of his now deceased father.

In 1916, the Thomas B. Jeffery Company was purchased by Charles W. Nash and became Nash Motors Company in 1917. The Jeffery brand name was dropped at the time of the sale and the manufacture of Nash branded automobiles commenced.

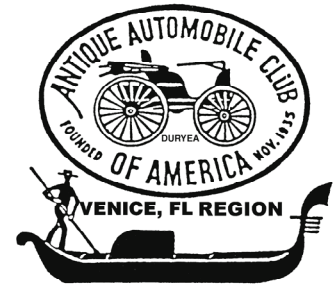
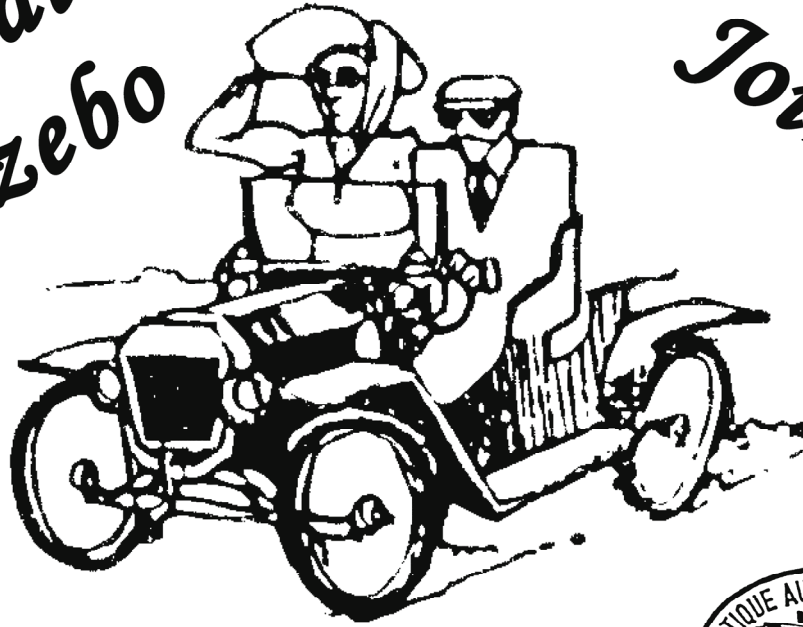

WHAT:

The Great Race is a cross-country rally that pits driver/navigator teams against the clock and against each other. This year's event will travel from the rocky shores of Maine to the palm trees of Florida, covering 18 cities and 13 states. Entrants will participate in a timed, controlled-speed, endurance competition over scenic public highways and roads. The scores for each team are the result of a team's ability to follow all designated course instructions precisely.

Following specific course instructions, teams navigate through 4 to 7 timed checkpoints each day. Their arrival time at each checkpoint is recorded and compared against the perfectly driven route, with each second off the perfect time, (either early or late) counted as penalty points. The winning team is the one with the lowest overall score (the most accurately driven route) at the end of the event.

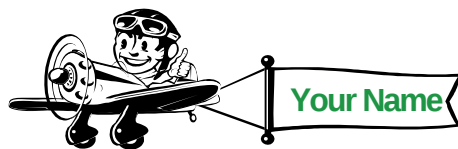
