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1919 Franklin Series 9 Brougham



Herbert H. Franklin founded the H. H. Franklin Manufacturing Company at Syracuse, New York in 1893. It was the first machine die-casting enterprise in the world. In 1901, he teamed up with engineer John Wilkinson to develop an air-cooled engine. The company was restructured and the **Franklin Automobile Company** was spun off into a separate entity. The Franklin automobile was introduced in 1902. It holds the distinction of being the first four-cylinder automobile produced in the United States.

The Franklin Automobile Company was a leader in innovation. Franklin cars were air-cooled, which was considered simpler and more reliable than water cooling. The company's advertisements and brochures explained that

air cooling did away with the "radiators, hoses, water pumps and headaches of 'normal' engine boiling and freezing." Franklin was first with six-cylinders (by 1905) and later that year, the first eight-cylinder engine was built by Wilkinson in preparation for the "Vanderbilt Cup" race by placing two four-cylinder engines in tandem. The automatic spark advance was introduced in 1907. In 1912, Franklin became the first to use a re-circulating type of oiling system.

Throughout its history, Franklin was a luxury brand and competed with other upscale automobiles of the day. As such, it fell victim to the Great Depression along with many luxury car manufacturers. The company sold about 150,000 cars over the course of more than 30 years in existence.
