Bryan is very proud of the fact, and he should be, to own a Corvette that he restored body off to be awarded a "Triple Crown Winner". This is an award that not many Corvette owners can claim. It is darn hard to obtain. It means that it has been "top flighted" (inspected thoroughly for authenticity, originality and top condition) to between 95 – 100 points. Then he has earned the coveted "Bloomington Gold Award" and to top this all off it has also won the "Gold Spinner Award".

Bryan's 1960 model has both the hard and soft tops, and the 283/270 HP motor

is coupled to a 4 speed transmission. He was looking for a 'Vette like this and found this one advertised in Hemmings Motor News. It was located in Canton, Georgia and had been stored in a basement there for 15 years. He has also traced all the history of the vehicle back to when it was sold new in Milwaukee, Wisconsin and even has obtained an original dealers promotional sales folio on the car. Bryan, as he is known to his friends, is a retired university professor, Dr. Bryan Talley, from Houston, Texas. He moved to the Venice area from Houston in August of 2013 and is a

neighbor of member John Destefano in Laurel Woodlands.

Also in the Talley stable can be seen a nicely restored 1964 Corvette Coupe and a newer addition of these exciting cars.

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1910 Thomas Model K6-70 Touring



The E.R. Thomas Company

was founded in Buffalo, NY in 1900

by Edwin Ross Thomas. He bought part of the Moribund Globe Cycle Company, and began building bicycles and motorcycles. In 1902, automobile production began in a new factory; the first car was a light single-cylinder car, joined shortly thereafter by a two-cylinder model and, eventually, a three-cylinder model which bore the name 'Thomas Flyer.'

The three-cylinder 'Flyer' was followed in 1904 by a four-cylinder engine that offered 40 horsepower. Production increased to 400. While Thomas was offering this powerful vehicle, they were working on a six-cylinder engine that would offer 60 horsepower. This engine

would continue Thomas's reputation as being built to the highest standards of design, construction and materials. The public recognized this and by 1906, Thomas had 1,514 orders in hand for cars. Expansion continued in 1907 with the introduction of the Thomas-Detroit, and then the legendary 72 horsepower Model K 6-70.

By 1907, the output was some 700 cars and 400 taxicabs, and each car produced had to prove itself capable of climbing Brewery Hill in Buffalo. But by 1910, Thomas production had slipped to 913 units, due to increased competition. E.R. Thomas, who in his decade in the motor industry had never learned to drive a car, sold his interest in the company, and the assets were eventually sold off in bankruptcy in 1913.

On January 16th Bunny and I were invited by a neighbor to travel to Kissimmee, Fla. for the Mecum Auto Auction. Needless to say I am not one to look a gift horse in the eye and say NO... We arrived at Osceola Heritage Park and the Silver Spur Arena where the auction is held. Upon arrival I went into cardiac arrest, the enormity alone was just very overwhelming.

The auction is a ten day event with over 3,000 cars not to mention all the auto marketer's such as GM , Interstate Battery, Edelbrock etc. to name a few and of course parts for all types of cars are available including antique cars. The cost for a TEN DAY bidder's pass is \$50 with a \$500 deposit amount placed on credit card of choice in case you buy a car. The regular admission price is \$20 and allows you only on the grounds to look at the cars in the tents and explore the vendors there....

We were amazed at the organization, each circus tent had 300 cars in it and each had a letter to designate the sale date (T=Tuesday) then the # signifying its place in line for the auction. Then there were three building's where the * Star Cars are kept, these are the investment graded cars and are kept under security guard.... Then of course you enter the Show Arena and discover the vastness of this enterprise. The seating is like being at a sports event. When we arrived at the Arena on day #1 we went directly to the tent for the next day's auction and viewed the auto's and made our bidding choices and marked them on our viewing sheets and essentially did the same every day, as the cars we had interest in were not up until the PM ...

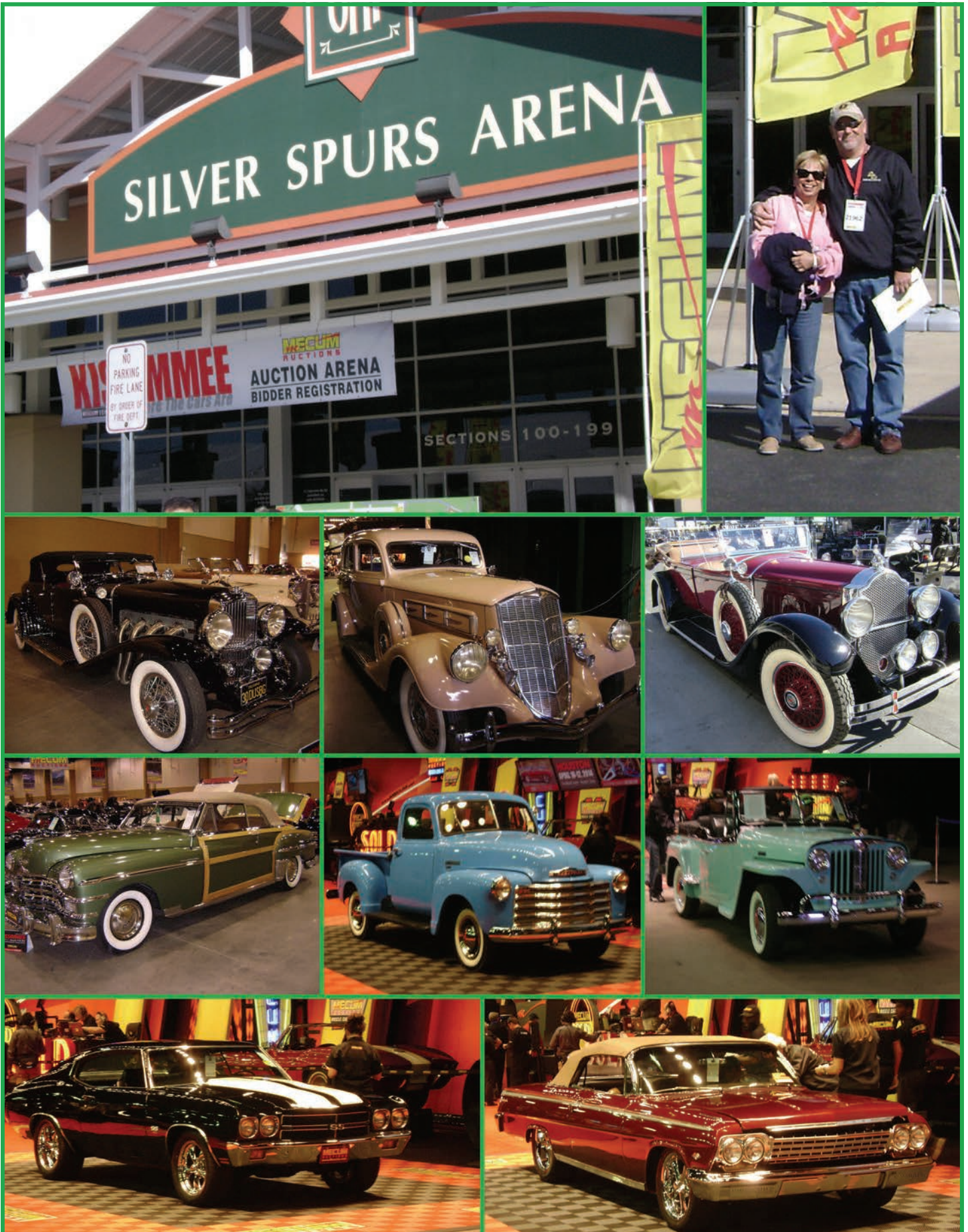

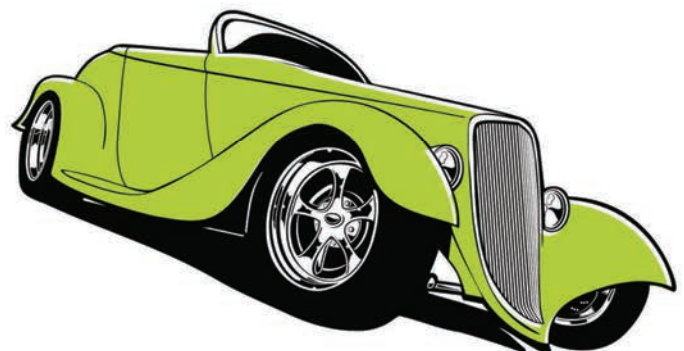

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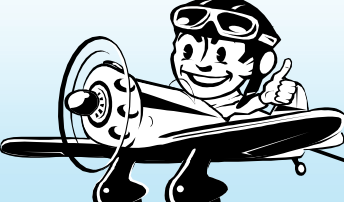
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
